## The Point Two SEEL Season Begins ...

The first event in the Point Two South East Eventers League calendar opened this year at Tweseldown after the sad loss of Stileman's from the calendar. Despite other events running at Oasby, Stafford and Poplar Park, the Hampshire venue accommodated over 1000 horses in four days and was blessed with sunshine and almost perfect going to repay the hard work of Brynley Powell and his team.

With many big names in attendance and the level of competition so high, wins were hard to come by for the local riders although Helen Sewell almost got SEEL off to an excellent start when she was just beaten in the opening BE100 section, finishing second on Drumbally Lady to Gloucestershire's Jay Halim. The big Open Intermediate classes did not have a southern winner between them, Antipodian ex pats keeping a stranglehold on first prizes but there were good placings for SEEL riders behind New Zealand's Andrew Nicholson and Australia's Stephen Way. Pippa Funnell was placed on both Pure Addiction and Mirage D'Elle. Emily Baldwin was among the ribbons on Pepper Anne but took Badminton bound Drivetime a little further afield to Suffolk's Poplar Park event where they were third in the AI. Emily Llewellyn also had a fall from Jackson D'alez, a new ride for her this season, but remained dry and was fit to compete later on Pardon Me, another local horse bound for Badminton.

Nici Wilson also had a good weekend, placed on her old campaigner Oingy Boingy and Porter Top Dollar

as well as winning a Novice section on Milchem Mardios. Tina Cook had a steady outing on Miner's Frolic who will be looking to add a World Title to his European one later this year and Francis Whittington was for once sedately clear on Sir Percival who will be seen in World Cup action at Burnham Market before his second Badminton attempt.

Francis was placed though on younger horse Easy Target. William Fox Pitt was steadily round on all his horses without any drama and new Kent resident Sharon Hunt, based these days at Bedgebury was placed on her Olympic horse Tankers Town. Sam Penn took her intermediates slowly but was delighted with the performance of veteran Captain Christy (see photo) who has had a heart operation over the winter. "He is back to being his old self" she said and was rewarded for this patience by winning a novice section on her exciting prospect Coever Diamond Clover. She then closed the event in good style by finishing first and second in the last Intro section on Sunday. "The horses are all coming along nicely" said the Golden Cross resident. Aileen Tizzard was another local who won a section, this time a BE90 with Alison Driver's Kavenagh II.

Gemma Tattersall and Sacha Pemble were notably absent from this event but only because they were competing on the Sunshine Tour where both had already been placed in the 1\* section. Gemma went one better this weekend though as she won the 2\*\* section on Kings Gem.
